



KidSafe UK EYFS Session 5 of 6: Computer and internet safety

Dear Parents/Carers,

Today in the KidSafe session we talked about children keeping themselves safe whilst using the internet. We also looked at age ratings for games and films. We gave KS a scenario where he had come across something 'yucky' on the computer and talked with children about what KS could do. We encouraged children to talk to their trusted grown-ups if this ever happened to them.

We also talked about age ratings that are on computer games and DVDs. We told the children that age ratings are there to keep them safe. To make this information easier to understand we explained the traffic signal system: green: all children can watch or play; amber: some children; red: no children. Please take the time to ask what your child what they have done in KidSafe and, if possible, please watch a green rated film with them and draw their attention to the colour of the age rating.
