### Leave of Absence

The law does not grant Parents /Carers an automatic right to take their child out of school for holidays during term-time. You must apply for permission in advance and the request for leave must come from a Parent /Carer with whom the child normally lives, and must be for the purpose of annual family holiday. These circumstances must be exceptional.

When deciding whether to allow term time leave the school will consider:

- \* The time and duration of the leave
- \* Your child's record of attendance
- \* Learning that will be missed

Exceptional circumstances which are:

- \* Service personnel returning from a tour of duty abroad where it is evidenced the individual will not be in receipt of any leave in the near future that coincides with school holidays.
- \* Where an absence from school is recommended by a health professional as part of a parent or child's rehabilitation from a medical or emotional issue.
- \* The death or terminal illness of a person close to the family.
- \* To attend a wedding or funeral of a person close to the family.
